The expenditure on teaching positions approved for above mentioned departments be incurred out of the funds provided under salary head (36).

The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (i) University may fill up the teaching positions at the earliest and explore the possibility to allocate the vacant teaching positions in the new areas where the requirement of teaching positions in a particular department is more needed.
- (ii) The University should strictly adhere the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC/PH as per Government of India/UGC guidelines while filling up the teaching positions.
- (iii) The UGC Regulations of 2010 relating to Minimum Qualification for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in University and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of Standards in Higher Education and as amended from time to time should be strictly followed.
- (iv) It is desirable that the Universities, especially the larger ones should focus on consolidation rather than horizontal expansion, to maintain quality.


