The EC ratified the creation of teaching positions and approved the creation of above teaching posts for the Department of Mathematics to make it a full-fledged department as per UGC norms.

EC: 49:37: To consider creation of teaching position in the existing Faculty of Commerce & Management to run the Management programme

The Council noted that even after 20 years of its existence, the University could not start a job-oriented course like Management due to various reasons. The University has received a sum of Rs.2 crore from UGC for setting up a department of Management. The Council further noted that as time was too short for holding FC and EC meetings, the following post was administratively created and advertised so as to enable the University to appoint one faculty at the beginning of the session itself to start a Diploma programme from the current academic session 2005-06.

EC: 49:38: To delimit consumption of petrol for the usage of official vehicles

The Council noted that with the appointment of more officers in the University the problem of keeping quarters in the campus as well as keeping vehicles for attending duties from their respective residences/quarters at Itanagar and Naharlagun will cause a heavy burden to the University. Hence, the University has to fix a maximum limit in respect of the consumption of petrol for the usage of official vehicle for the outside office use (private use). Secondly, an officer who is entitled to a vehicle and stays at Naharlagun/Itanagar shall not be allowed to retain a quarter in the University campus.

The Council also noted that the F.C. accepted both the proposals and recommended to E.C.

The EC indeed felt that there should be some limit in the petrol consumption by the officers in the university. The Council after going through the matter broadly decided that both entitlements together will not be made available to the officers and the item on consumption of
