1. Games and Sports:

Double and Mixed Double
  - (b) Track – 100 and 200 meter race (Male and Female Individual)
2. Cultural:
  - (a) Folk Dance (live)
  - (b) Duet Dance
  - (c) Solo Song
3. Literary:
  - (a) Debate
  - (b) Essay
  - (c) Extempore Speech

#### **Instruction, Rules and Regulations of the RGU XIII Edition of Inter-College Youth Festival-2025**

1. The detailed entry form in Google sheet link is attached to the email of this invitation letter.
2. Each affiliated College/Institute will be allowed to bring 14-16 contingents, including an escort.
3. A registration for participation must be done online on or before 8th March 2025, with a payment of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only. To this effect, a Google Form will be live from 5th to 8th March 2025.
4. A caution deposit of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only (refundable) shall be collected at the time of arrival.
5. Logistics including accommodation, food, and local transportation will be provided by the host (RGU).

6. The participating affiliated colleges should bring their own College flag for the march Past. Participation of the team in the march past is essential.
7. The participating affiliated colleges/Institutes are requested to bring their own bedding. Host will not be providing any bedding.
8. Participation is requested to bring their own lock and key for the safety of their belongings. The Host will not be responsible for any loss of any item.
9. The Host is not responsible for any incident happen outside the campus with escort/coach/manager/team of the player.
10. All participants must carry their institutional identity cards and a bonafide certificate issued by their respective Heads of Institution.
11. The Undertaking letter should be submitted by the participation/ Affiliated College/Institute on arrival to registration desk.
12. Events and competition categories: A detailed list of events will be shared along with the invitation letter. Participants must register for individual and group events within the given deadlines.
13. The team should report for their match/ Events at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the schedule.
14. Code of Conduct: All participants must adhere to the discipline and decorum of the festival. Misconduct or violation of rules may lead to disqualification.
15. Dress Code: Participants must wear their institutional uniform or appropriate cultural attire during performances.
16. Medical Assistance: Basic first aid and emergency medical support will be available at the venue. Participants are advised to carry their prescribed medications if needed.
17. Transportation: Arrangements will be made for pick-up and drop-off from the nearest transport hubs for outstation participants.
18. Prize Distribution: Awards and certificates will be given to winners of individual and group events during the valedictory function.
19. Environmental Responsibility: Participants are requested to maintain cleanliness and follow eco-friendly practices during the festival.
20. Security & Safety: The host institution will ensure adequate security measures. However, participants are responsible for their personal belongings.
21. The organizing Chairman/ Secretary Reserves the right to make any changes in the programme and the venue, if necessary, which will be final and binding on the participation colleges.

## SPECIAL RULES FOR THE CULTURAL, LITERARY AND SPORTS & GAMES:

### Cultural Events:

#### **1. Folk dance:**

- a. Participants – 12 maximum + 3 accompany
- b. Time limit : 5 minutes
- c. Arunachal based tribe only
- d. No track music only Live
- e. Strict punctuality should be maintained or else the team shall be disqualified

#### **2. Duet dance:**

- a. Time limit: 4 minutes – extra time shall be negatively marked
- b. Bollywood item
- c. Can make use of music track
- d. To wear the decent costume
- e. Report half an hour before the schedule time.

#### **3. Solo song:**

- a. Time limit: 4 minutes
- b. Type of song: Open (classical, semi-classical, etc)
- c. Can make use of track and instruments (any)

### **Guidelines for the Literary Competitions**

#### **1. General.**

- a. There shall be three literary events- Debate, Extempore Speech, and Essay Writing.
- b. A participant in each event shall represent each college.
- c. All participants are to dress formally or present themselves with traditional dress.
- d. The participants must carry their ID Cards during their participation.
- e. The first three winners will be awarded. There shall be consolation prizes (certificates) for the fourth and fifth winners.

#### **2. Debate Competition**

- a. The topic for the debate competition shall be intimated in advance.
- b. The participants have to speak either in English or Hindi.
- c. Each participant shall be allotted 5 minutes.
  - A warning bell rings after the fourth minute.
  - A final bell rings when the time limit is up.
- d. One extra minute shall be allotted to the first speakers(Both for and against the motion).
- e. The colleges/participants for/against the motion shall be decided by draw of lots.
- f. There shall be a speaker and a three-member jury.
- g. In the case of a tie, the winner will be decided by the panel of judges mutually.
- h. The marks shall be awarded as per the following criteria

### 3. Extempore Speech

- A bunch of the topics will be given to select anyone randomly.
- The participants have to speak either in English or Hindi.
- Each participant will be given 5 minutes to speak extempore on a topic picked up by him or her.
- The maximum time limit to think over the topic will be 1 minute and the maximum time for speech will be 4 minutes.
- The participant will be allowed to select the topic once only.
- There shall be a three-member jury.
- In the case of a tie, the winner will be decided by the panel of judges mutually.
- The marks shall be awarded as per the following criteria

### 4. Essay Writing

- There shall be the on-the-spot intimation of the topic for the competition.
- The participants have to write either in English or Hindi.
- The word limit for the essay is 1000 words.
- Each participant shall be allotted 1 hour.
- There shall be a three-member jury.
- In the case of a tie, the winner will be decided by the panel of judges mutually.
- The marks shall be awarded as per the following criteria

2.	Originality	20
3.	Creativity	20
4.	Effective use of language	10

### Guidelines for Badminton Team Competition:

#### 1. General Rules:

The tournament will be played in a **team format**, where each team competes in **three matches**:

- **Men's Doubles (MD)**
- **Women's Doubles (WD)**
- **Mixed Doubles (XD)**

1.2 The team **winning at least two out of three matches** will be declared the winner of the tie.

1.3 The tournament will follow a **knockout format**, with teams eliminated after a loss.

1.4 The **draws will be conducted randomly** before the tournament starts.



## **2. Match Format:**

### **2.1 Pre-Semifinal Rounds (Up to Quarterfinals)**

- Matches will be played in a **best-of-three (3) games** format.
- Each game will be played **up to 11 points**.
- A team must win by **at least 2 points** if the score reaches 10-10.
- Maximum 15 points.

### **2.2 Semifinals & Final**

- Matches will be played in a **best-of-three (3) games** format.
- Each game will be played **up to 21 points**.
- A team must win by **at least 2 points** if the score reaches 20-20.
- Maximum 30 points.

## **3. Match Conduct & Regulations**

### **3.1 Order of Play**

- The order of play in each tie will be:
  1. **Men's Doubles**
  2. **Women's Doubles**
  3. **Mixed Doubles**

### **3.2 Player Participation**

- Each team must have **at least two male and two female players** to ensure separate entries in each category.

### **3.3 Walkover & Forfeits**

- If a team fails to field a pair for a scheduled match, the opposing team will be awarded a **walkover** for that match.
- A team missing two or more matches in a tie will be declared the loser of that tie.

### **3.5 Officiating & Disputes**

- An umpire and line judges will oversee each match.
- Any disputes must be resolved immediately by the umpire in presence of tournament referee, whose decision will be final.

### **3.6 Equipment & Attire**

- Matches will be played using Yonex Mavis 350 shuttlecocks.
- Players must wear non-marking shoes and proper and matching sports attire.

## **Guidelines for (Track) Athletics Events:**

### **1. General Rules:**

#### **1.1 Track Events (Male and Female Individual)**

- **100m Sprint (Male/Female)** – Only one participant can represent each affiliated college/institute in each category.
- **200m Sprint (Male/Female)** – Only one participant can represent each affiliated college/institute in each category.

1.2 The event will adhere to the World Athletics (WA) rules and regulations.

1.3 Participants must report to the call room at least 30 minutes before their scheduled event.

### **2. Race Format:**

- Conducted in heats, semifinals and finals (if applicable).
- If the number of participants is limited, direct finals may be held.
- The fastest competitors from the heats (based on time and placement) will qualify for the next round.



### **3. Race Conduct & Regulations:**

#### **3.1 Lane Discipline**

- Athletes must stay within their designated lanes.
- Lane infringement may lead to disqualification.

#### **3.2 False Starts**

- Only one false start per race is allowed; any subsequent false start results in disqualification.

#### **3.3 Disqualification**

- Improper lane changing, obstruction of other runners, or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification.

#### **3.4 Timing & Results**

- Electronic timing will be used for accurate results.

### **4. Equipment & Attire:**

- Athletes must wear appropriate running spikes or non-marking shoes.
- Participants must wear proper sports attire representing their team or institution.
- Starting blocks may be provided by the organizers (on special request).
- Personal starting blocks may be used if approved by officials.

### **5. Officiating & Disputes:**

- A race referee, timekeepers, and track marshals will oversee the competition.
- Starter officials will signal the beginning of races.

### **6. Awards:**

- **1st Place** – Gold Medal & Certificate.
- **2nd Place** – Silver Medal & Certificate.
- **3rd Place** – Bronze Medal & Certificate.
