CIRCULAR

In view of the upcoming All Arunachal Pradesh Students' Union (AAPSU) Election – 2026, and pursuant to the request received from the Rajiv Gandhi University Students' Union (RGUSU), measures are being taken to maintain a peaceful and congenial academic atmosphere on the campus.

The Senior Security Officer is requested to ensure strict checking of both vehicular as well as pedestrian movement through the university main gate especially during night hours.

All members of the university community are requested to extend their full cooperation to the security personnel for implementing these measures effectively.


