<p>EC:65.06</p>	<p>To recognize official designation of core administrative branches and re-designate Accounts Branch as “Budget & Accounts” Currently, the following administrative Branches may be recognized as the core functional branches in the Administration (other than academic departments).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Academic and Conference 2. Administration 3. Establishment (Sub-Division as Teaching & Non-Teaching) 4. Examinations (UG & PG) 5. Estate 6. Bill & DDO 7. Finance (Audit) 8. Project Cell 9. Store and Purchase 10. Official Language (Raj Bhasa Cell) 11. Computer Centre 12. Health Centre <p>Further, in order to strengthen accountability and administrative control, it is proposed that each branch/division be headed by a Group ‘A’ Officer at least at the level of Assistant Registrar or equivalent, subject to approval of the Competent Authority and in accordance with the delegation of powers.</p> <p>It is also proposed to re-designate the “Accounts Branch” as “Accounts & Budget” to better reflect its functional responsibilities and in align with the functioning of Government in the Centre and State. The Hon’ble High Court, in Writ Petition No. WP (C)/401/2024 dated 12.02.2026 in the case of Nich Babu vs. RGU has dismissed the petition and upheld the position of the respondent University, thereby allowing the University to proceed with the ongoing recruitment process notified in the year 2024. 2. This judgment has also reaffirmed the legality and validity of the UGC Model Cadre Recruitment Rules as approved by the Executive Council in its 48th meeting held on 08.12.2022. 3. In view of the above, approval of the Executive Council is solicited for undertaking recruitment (by way of Promotion and/or Direct Recruitment) to all notified Group ‘B’ & ‘C’ non-teaching positions under the <i>Mission Mode Recruitment</i> initiative of the <i>Government of India</i>. A committee was constituted vide order No. Estt-NT/705/2025 dated 29th July, 2025 to examine the parity of remuneration for contractual employees and devise a policy on uniform fixation commensurate to years of service, in accordance with the Minimum Wages Policy of the Government of India. 2. The committee has since prepared its report with details. The minutes of the committee, along with the detailed policy, slab formula, and relevant illustrations, are enclosed herewith. <p>EC:65.10</p>	<p>To Consider the payment of terminal benefits in case of Late Dr. Manjunath, Ex-Associate professor- reg</p> <p>Dr. Manjunath Bangalore Govinda Raju served as an Assistant Professor in the School of Management and Statistics at the University of Hyderabad from 13.03.2017 to 03.02.2024. He tendered a technical resignation from his substantive post to join Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU). He subsequently joined Rajiv Gandhi University as an Associate Professor in the Department of Statistics with effect from 05.02.2024.</p> <p>Dr. Manjunath Bangalore Govinda Raju unfortunately passed away on 31.12.2024 at 9:30 PM at his residence in Bangalore.</p> <p>The family of the deceased employee is eligible for terminal benefits, including:</p> <p>Death Gratuity Leave Encashment</p> <p>As Rajiv Gandhi University is the last employer, it is typically responsible for the final disbursement of terminal benefits. Further, as the employee had resigned on technical grounds, his previous service of 6 years, 10 months, and 21 days at the University of Hyderabad qualifies to be counted towards total qualifying service for terminal benefits.</p> <p>Additionally, the unutilized Earned Leave and Half Pay Leave from the University of Hyderabad may have been carried forward to Rajiv Gandhi University, subject to applicable rules.
